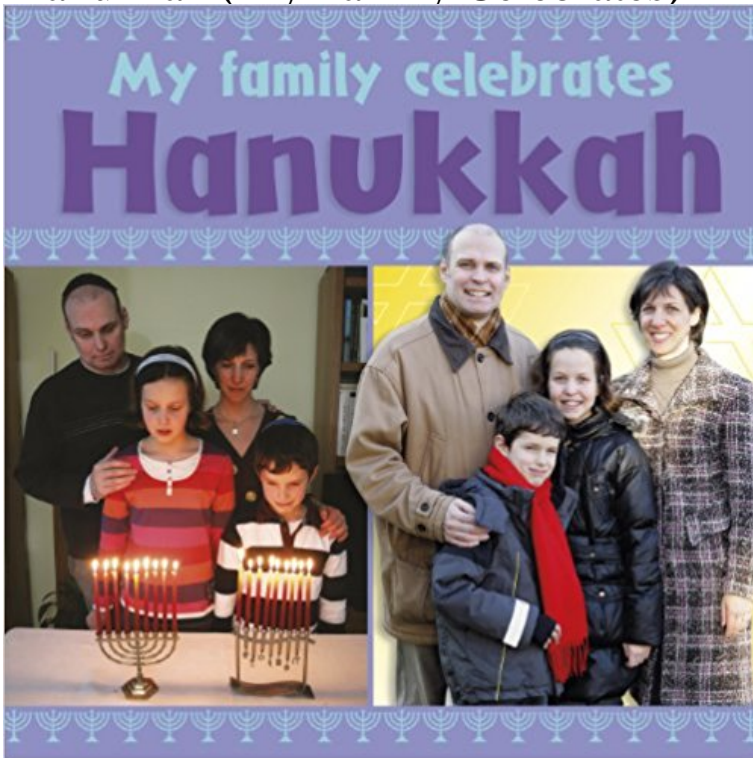


Hanukkah (My Family Celebrates)
