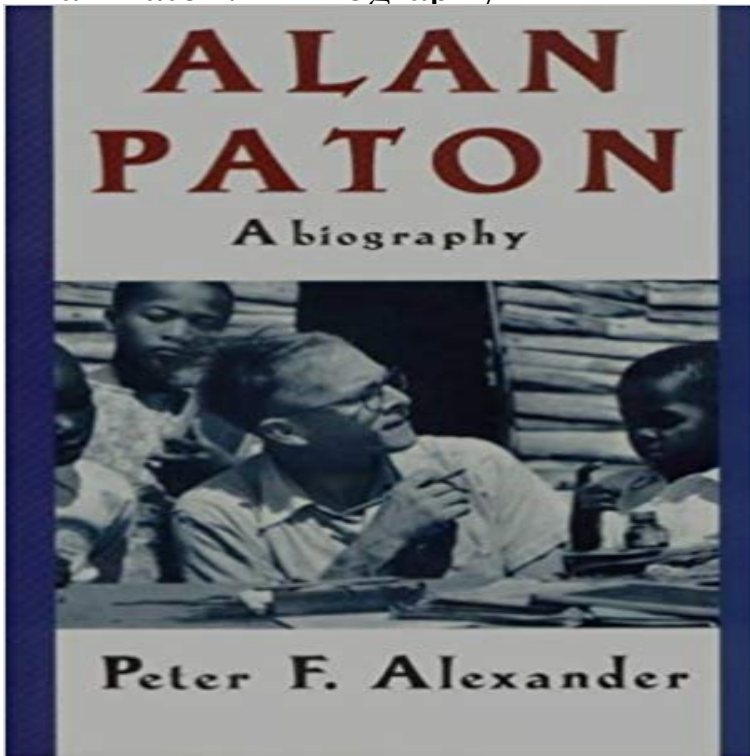


Alan Paton: A Biography
