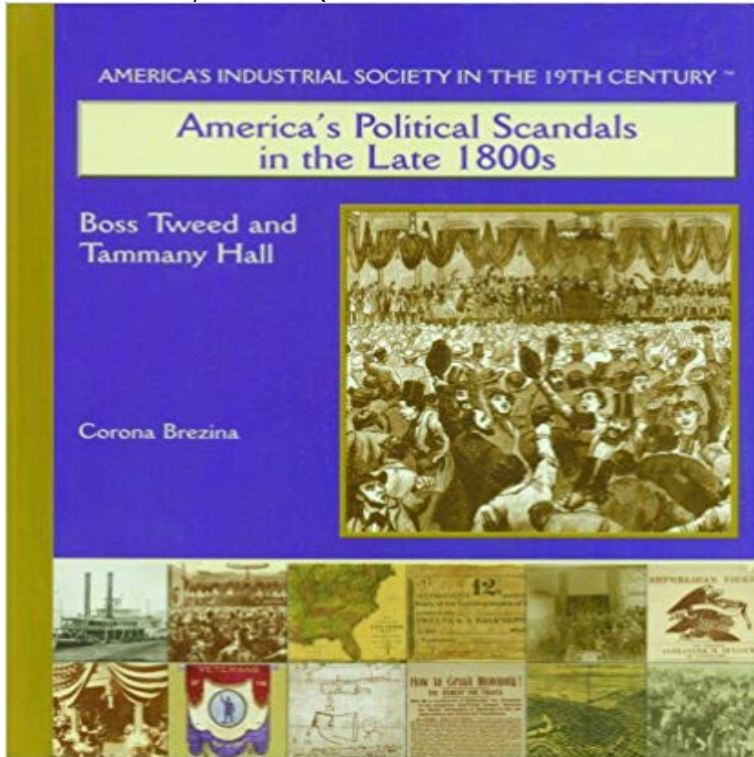


# Americas Political Scandals in the Late 1800s: Boss Tweed and Tammany Hall (Life in the New American Nation)
