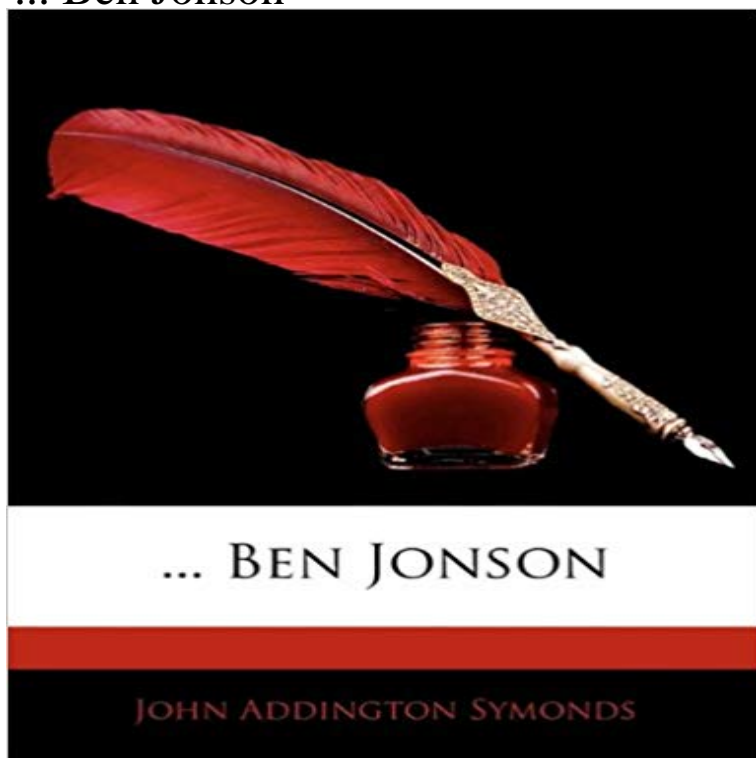


## ... Ben Jonson
