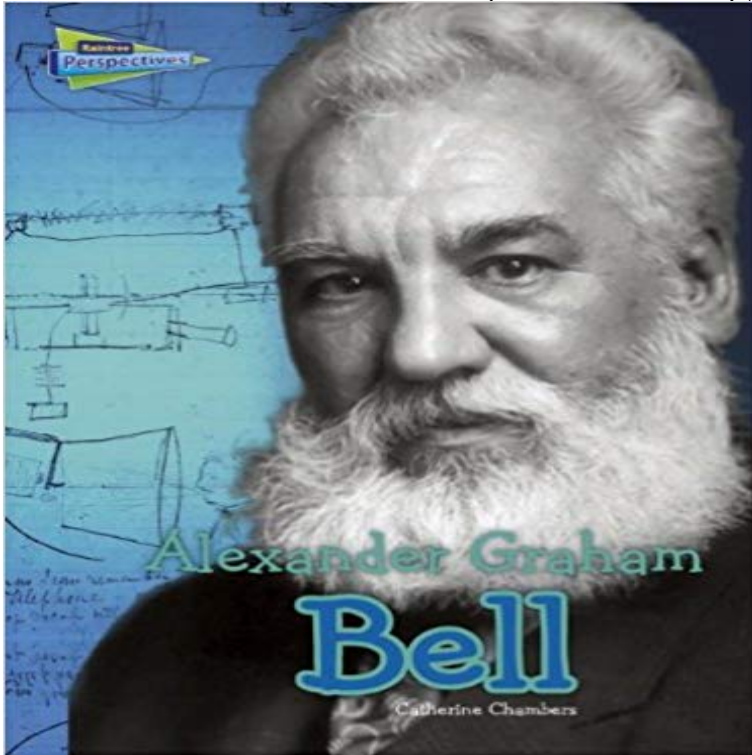


Alexander Graham Bell (Science Biographies)
