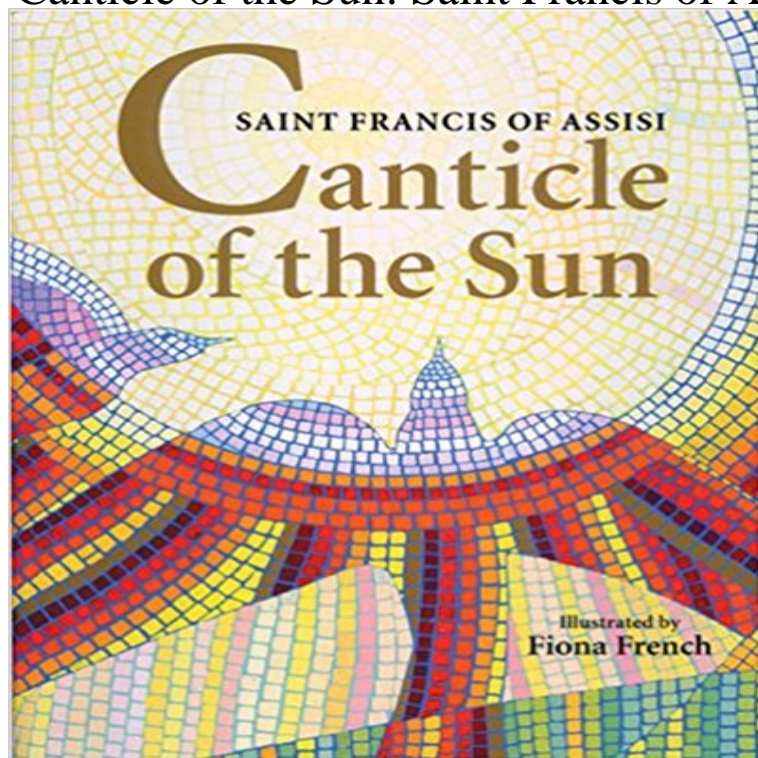


Canticle of the Sun: Saint Francis of Assisi
