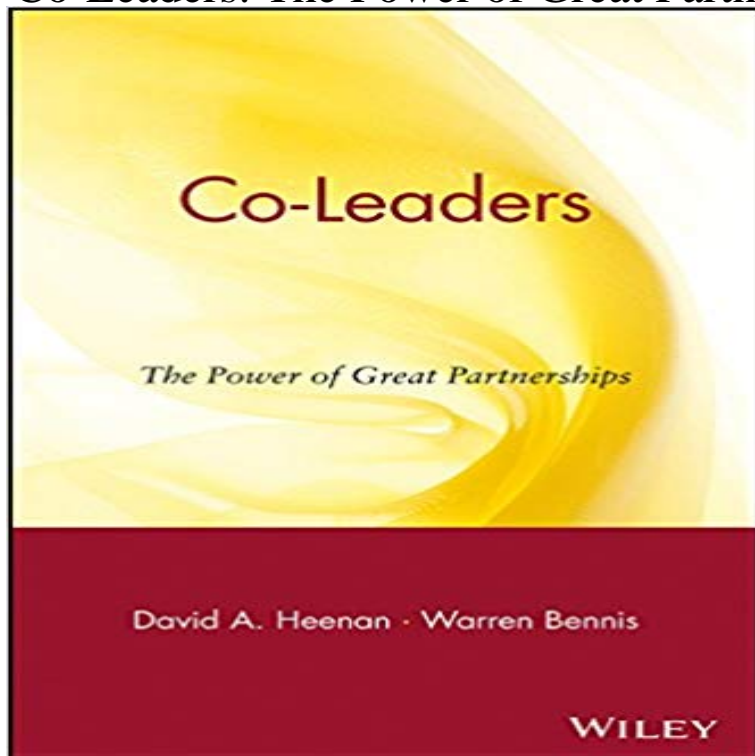


Co-Leaders: The Power of Great Partnerships
