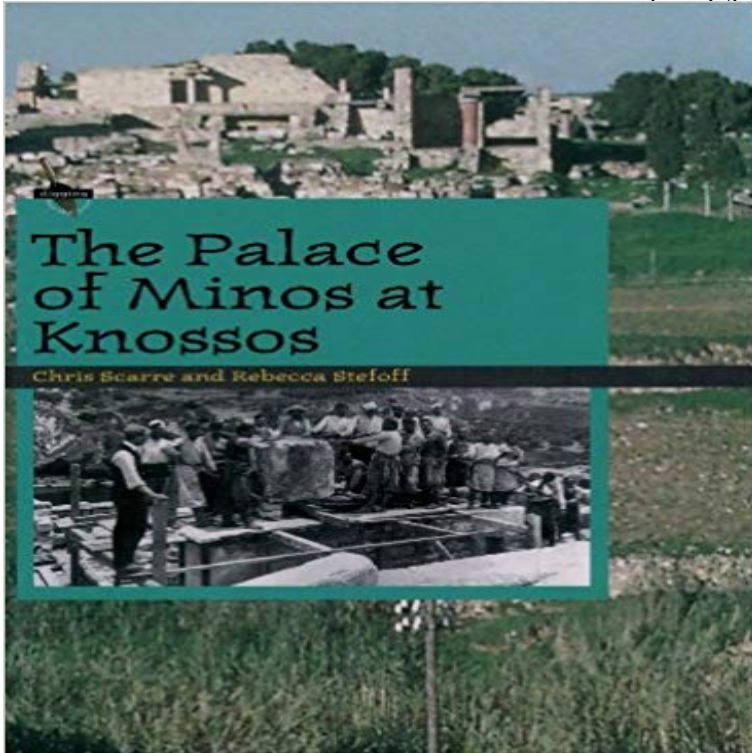


The Palace of Minos at Knossos (Digging for the Past)
