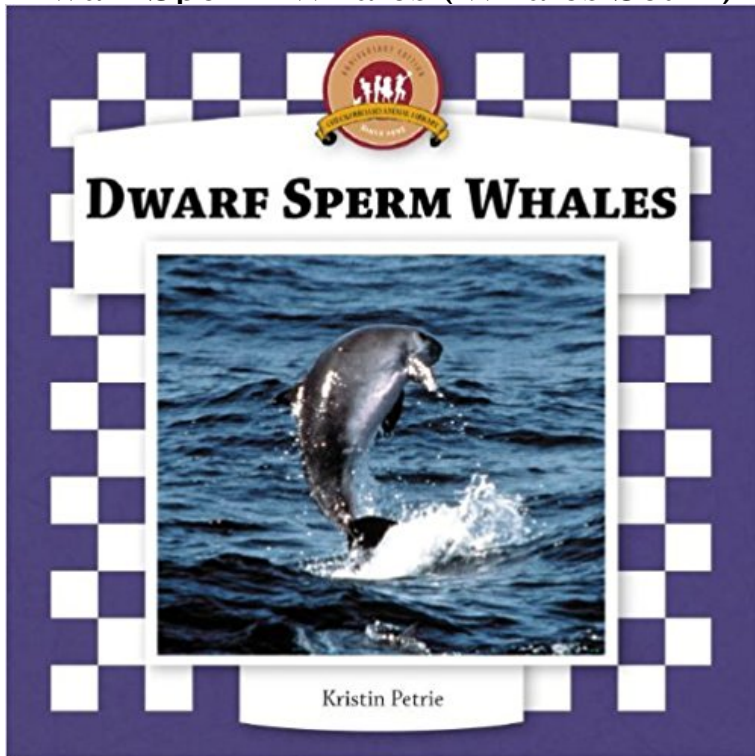


Dwarf Sperm Whales (Whales Set II)
