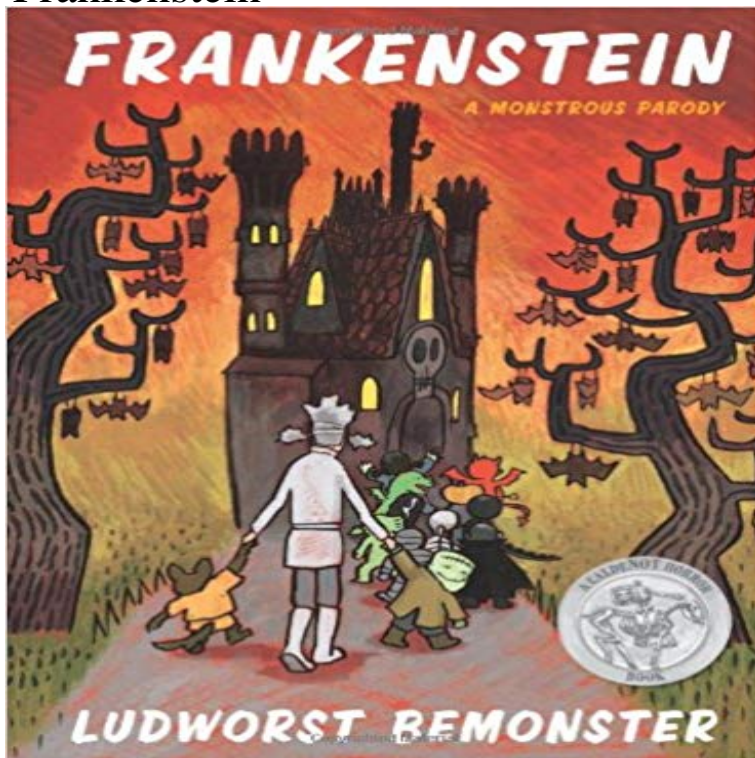


# Frankenstein
