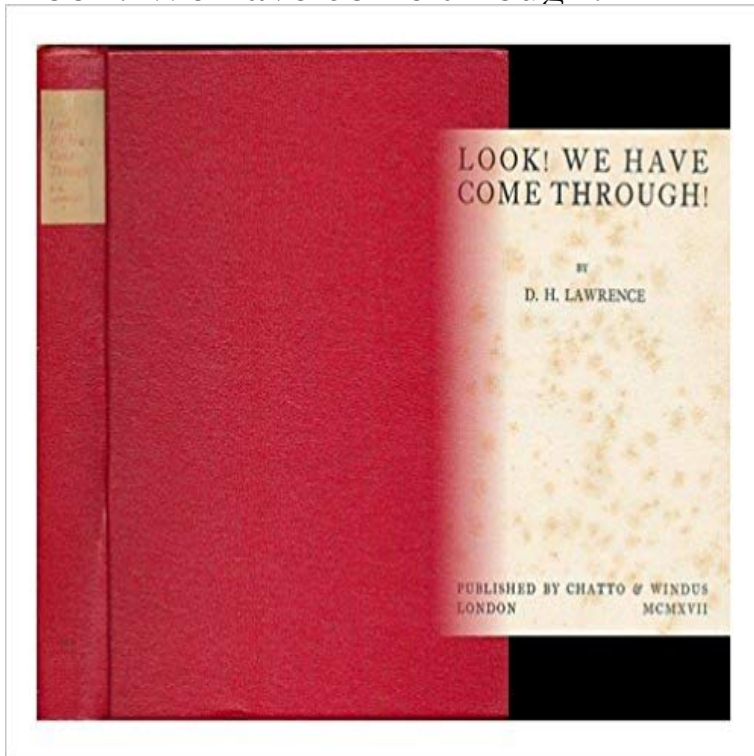


Look! We have come through!
