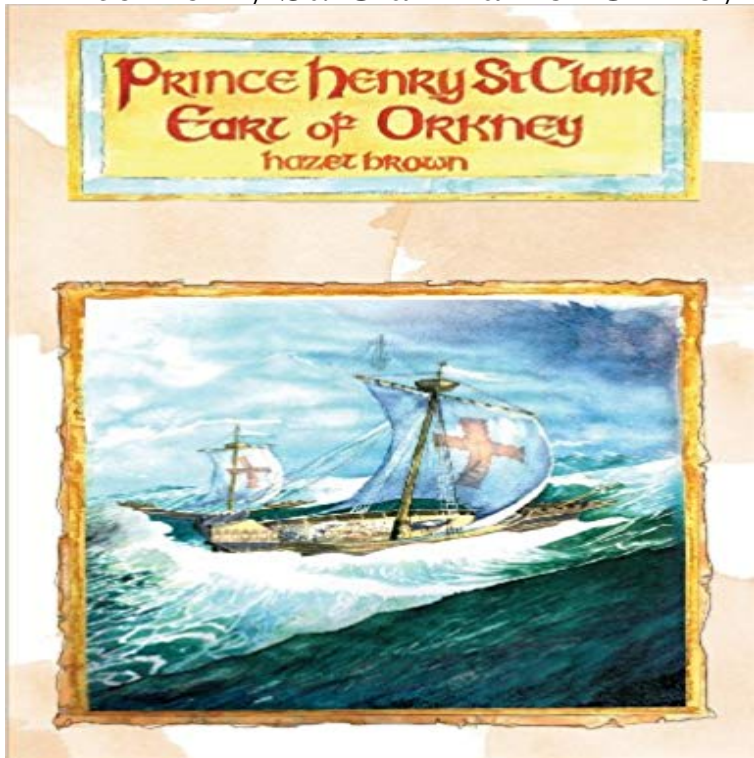


Prince Henry St. Clair Earl of Orkney
