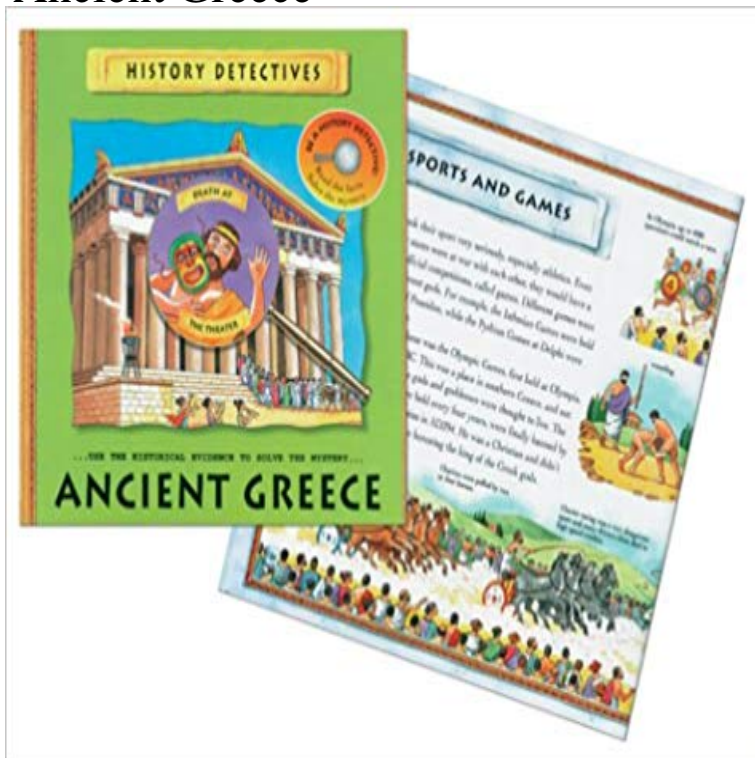


Ancient Greece
