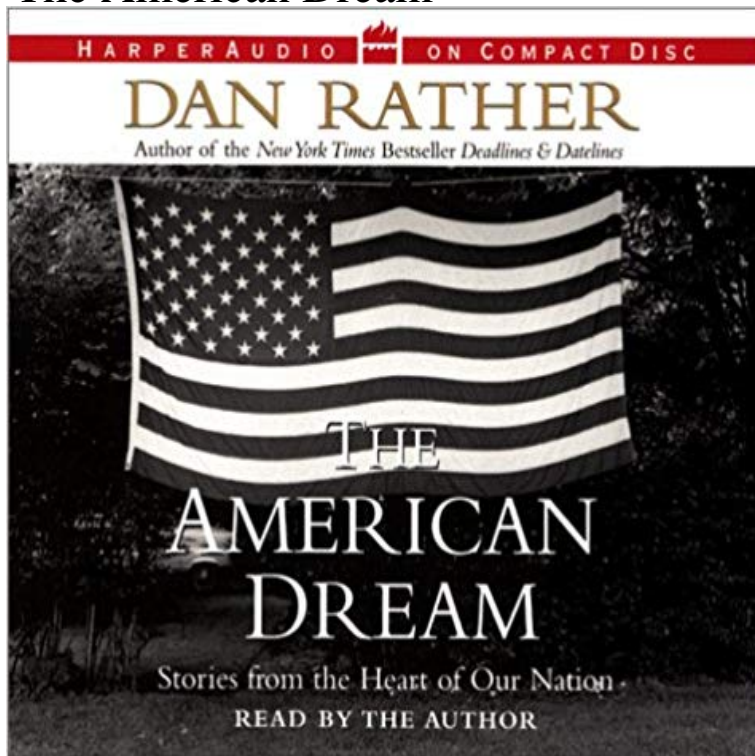


The American Dream
