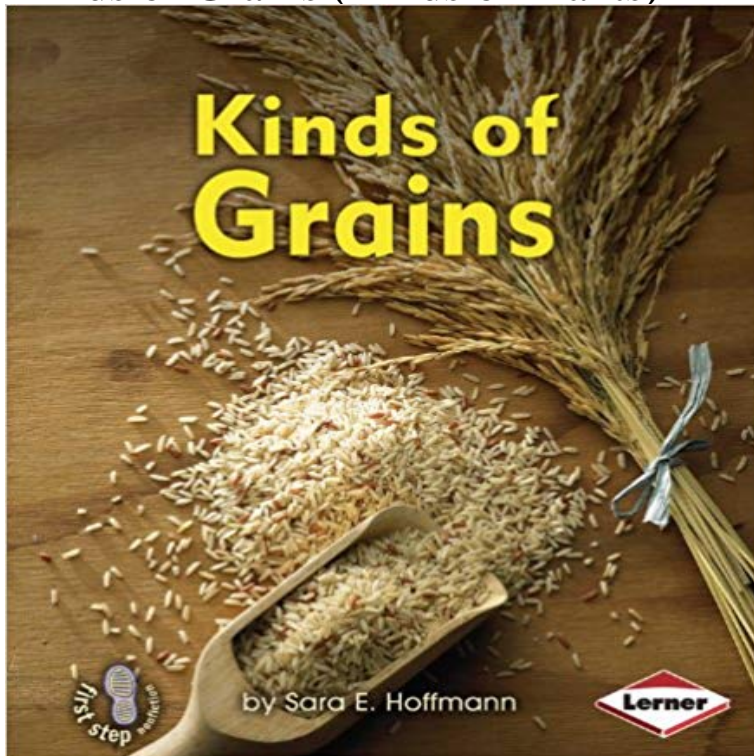


Kinds of Grains (Kinds of Plants)
