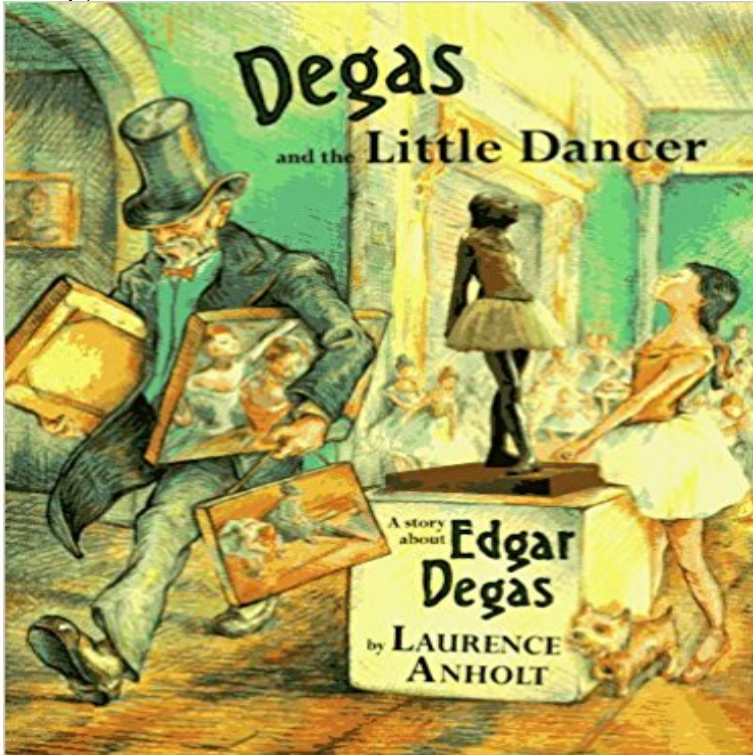


Degas and the Little Dancer
