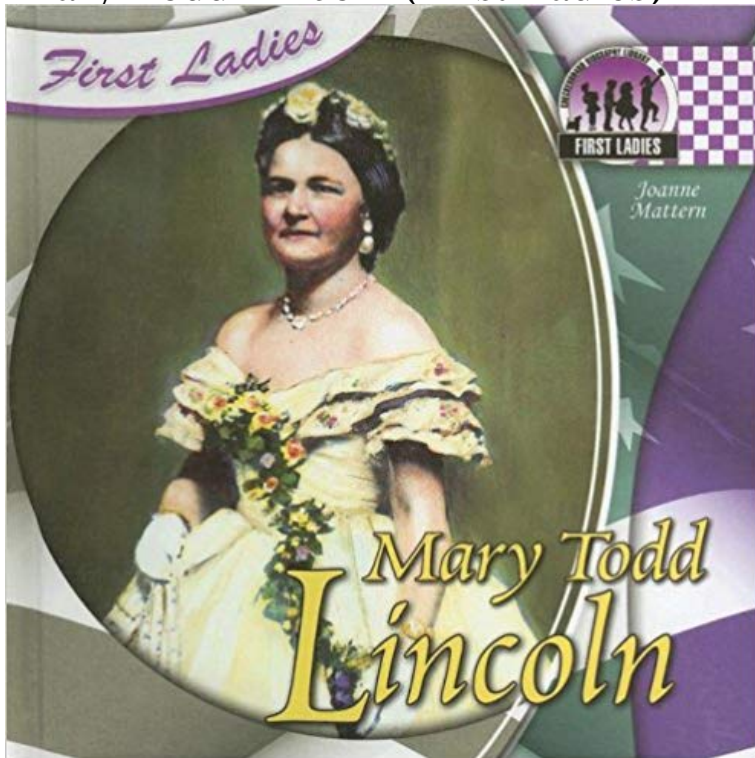


Mary Todd Lincoln (First Ladies)
