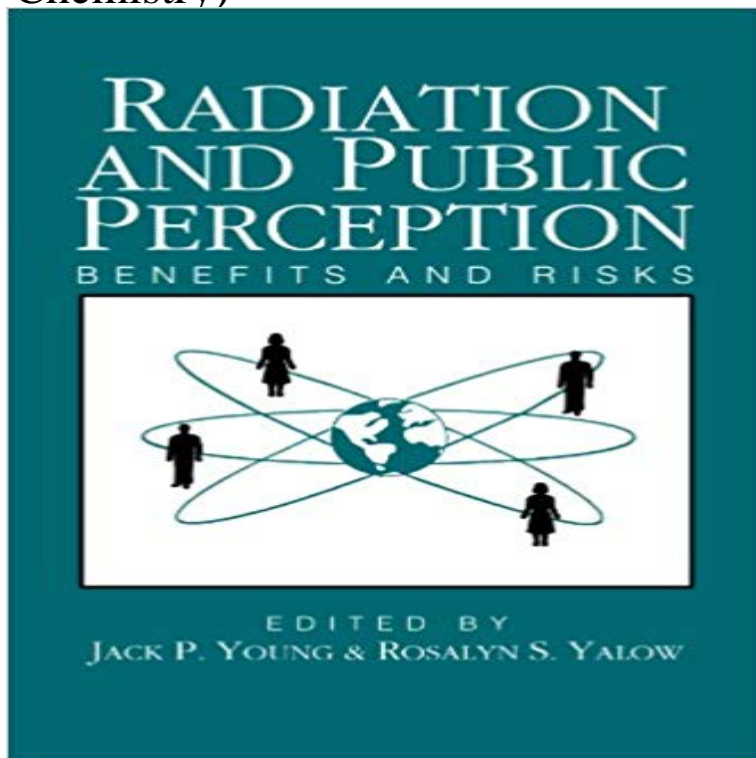


Radiation and Public Perception: Benefits and Risks (ACS Advances in Chemistry)

Includes an overview chapter by Rosalyn S. Yalow, recipient of the 1977 Nobel Prize in medicine for her work in developing radioimmunoassay techniques.
