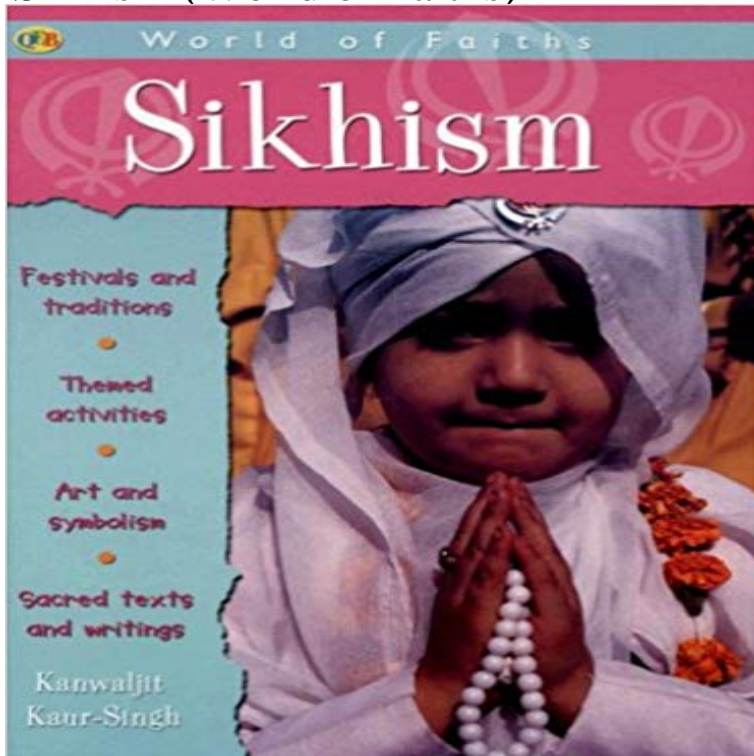


## Sikhism (World of Faiths)
