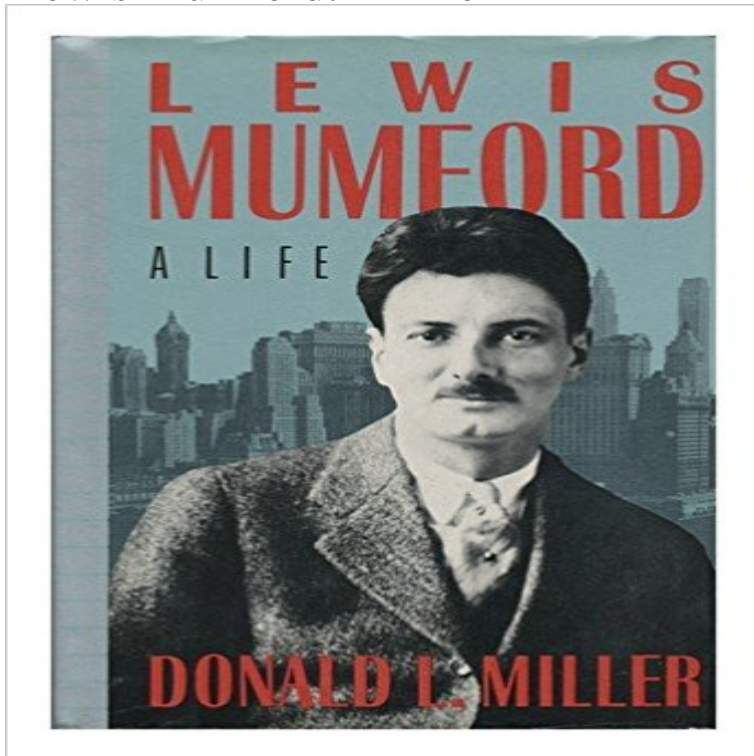


Lewis Mumford: A Life
