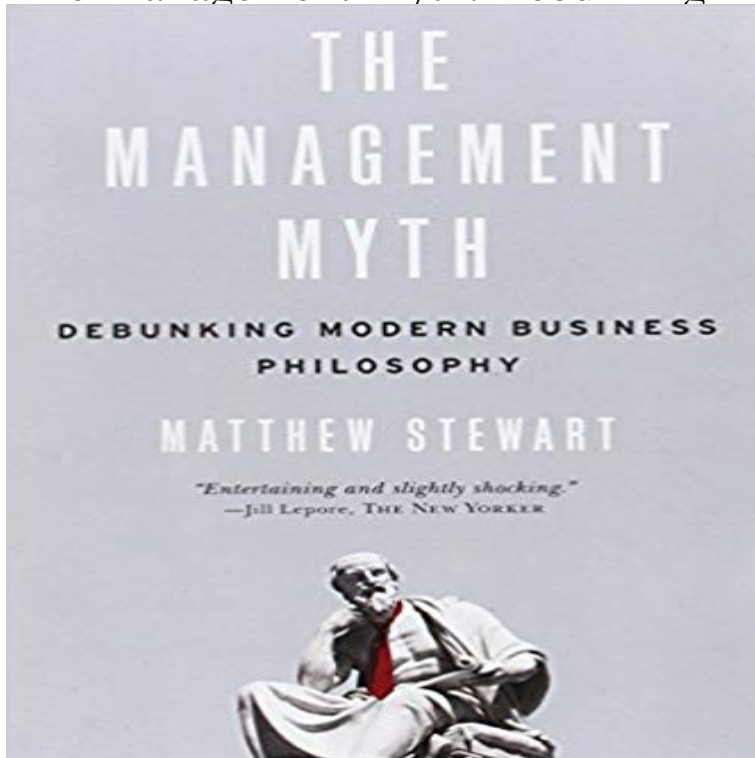


The Management Myth: Debunking Modern Business Philosophy
