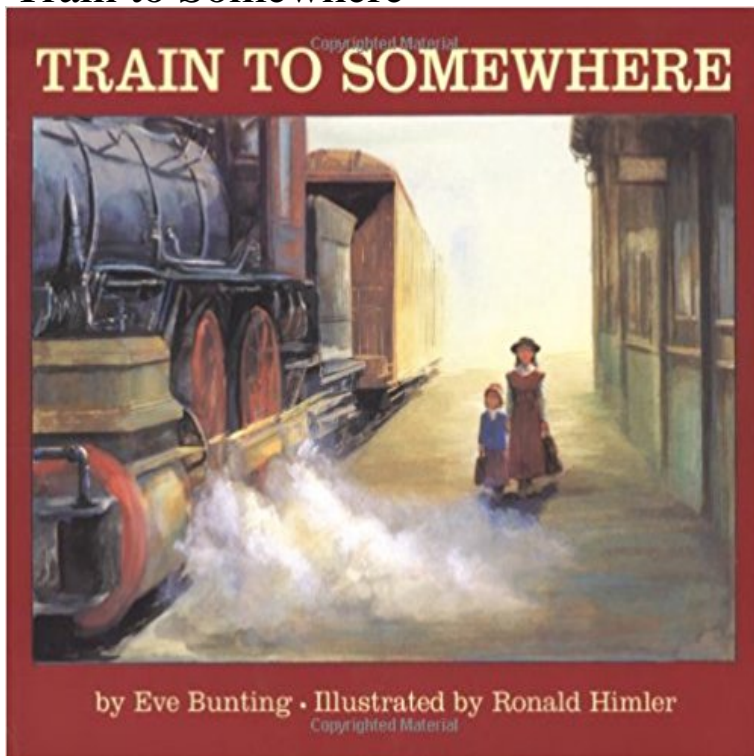


Train to Somewhere
