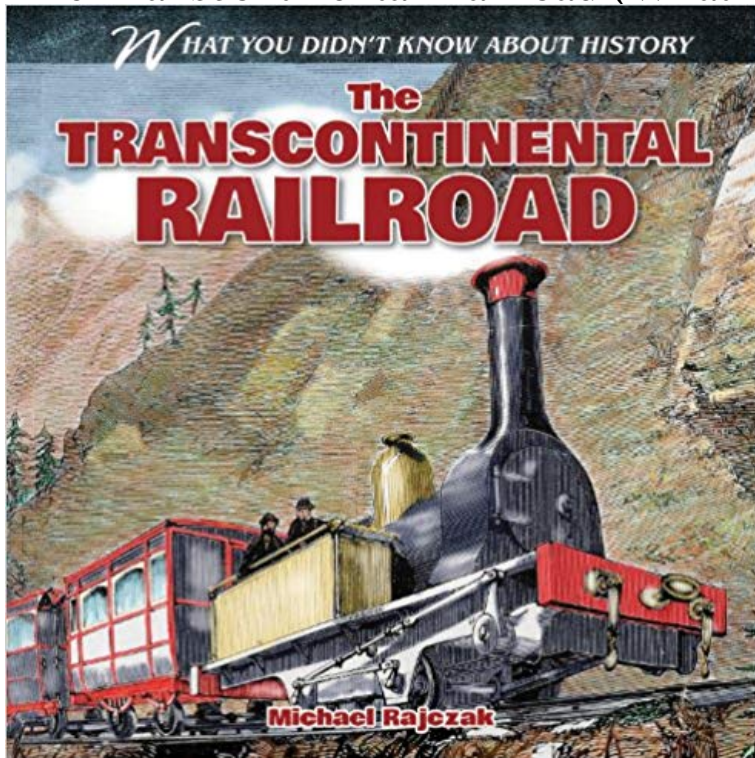


The Transcontinental Railroad (What You Didn't Know about History)
