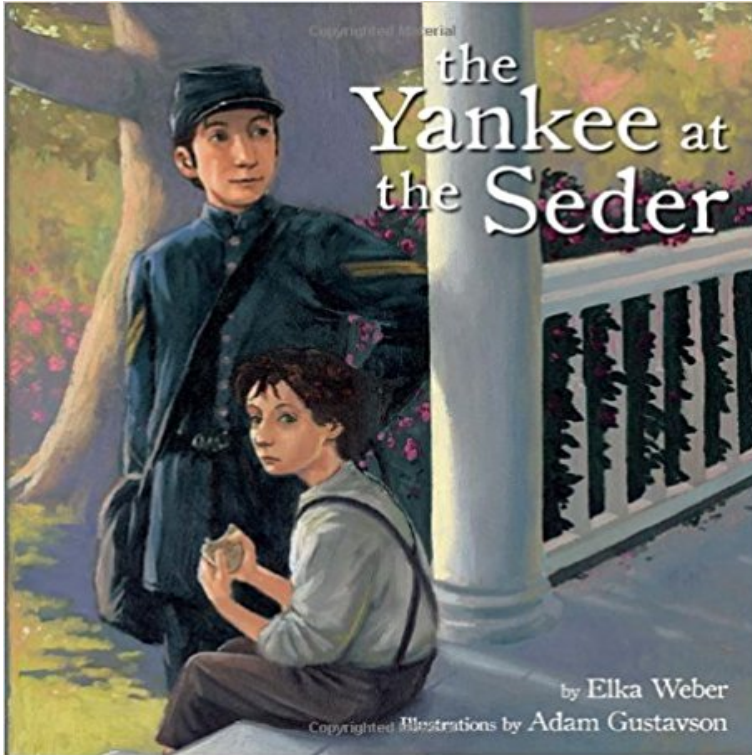


The Yankee at the Seder
