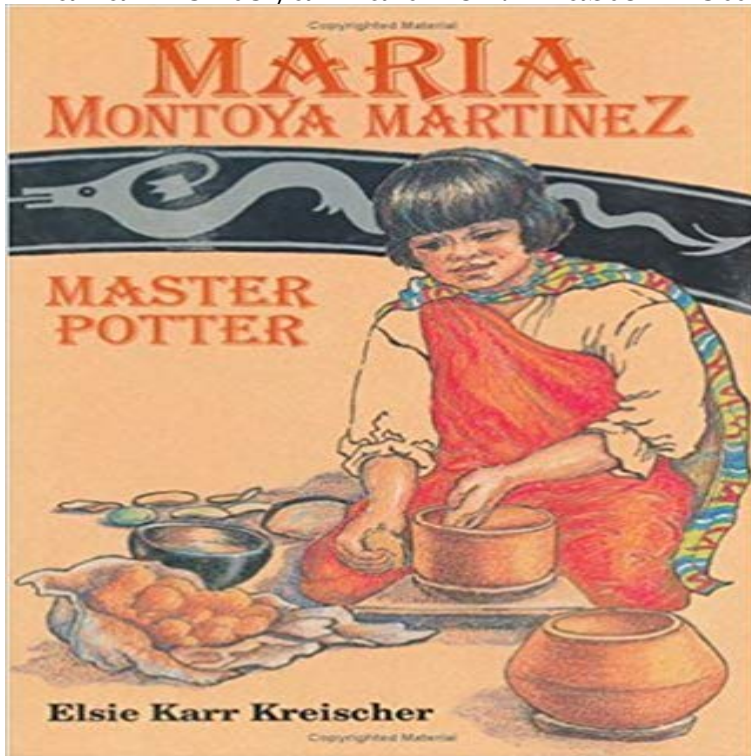


## Maria Montoya Martinez: Master Potter
